





CALL FOR PARTICIPANTS FOR A NORDIC RISE UP! -SEMINAR

13-16 November 2025 in Helsinki, Finland

We are looking for participants from Finland, Norway and Sweden to attend the **Nordic RiseUp!** seminar which will be organized in **Helsinki**, **Finland on 13-16 November 2025**. <u>RiseUp!</u> is a feminist leadership programme for girls and young women in all their diversity. RiseUp! was developed with and for young people by World YWCA. The seminar is organised by YWCA of Finland, YWCA-YMCA of Sweden and YMCA-YWCA of Norway.

The seminar will bring girls and young women together from Finland, Norway and Sweden to discuss feminist leadership in the Nordic countries and to design a longer RiseUp! -leadership programme to the Nordic context. The training programme will start in 2026.

Each country will have six (6) seats in the seminar. The age range for participants is 16-25. We are looking for participants who are interested in value-based leadership, the feminist movement and engaging in their own community. Previous experience in the YMCA/YWCA movement and their training programmes is a plus.

The event is funded through a grant from the Nordic Culture Fund and therefore travel, meals and lodging will be covered by the organisers. The event will take place in **Hotel Helka** (www.hotelhelka.com) in central Helsinki. All participants will be accommodated in single rooms.
